The United Nations designates specific days, weeks, years, and decades to highlight events or topics/themes aimed at promoting awareness and action around strategic activities usually proposed by UNESCO Member States. Each international event offers opportunities to organize activities related to the theme of the day, week, year or decade for organizations and offices of the United Nations system, governments, civil society, the public and private sectors, schools, universities and, more generally, citizens, as a springboard for awareness-raising actions.
